SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Candidate must notify the Chairman of the Committee by submitting an application by April 29, 2018 to the following address:

- 2. The Application form must be filled out completely by the candidate and sent to the above address in the time specified or it will not be considered. The candidate must also include an essay described in the application or the application will not be considered.
- 3. The application deadline is April 29, 2018. Applications received after April 29, 2018 will not be considered.
- 4. All material submitted becomes property of the Holbrook Sportsmen's Club and none will be returned. The scholarship committee determines the winner at its sole discretion.
- 5. In the event the winner cannot accept or does not qualify for the award, it will be awarded to the next best qualified candidate. Should the qualified winner fail to fulfill the conditions of the scholarship, however no such award will be made.
- 6. The money is to be paid to the scholar at, or for the beginning of the second semester of the freshman year, after demonstrating and evidencing successful completion of the first semester of the current academic year.
- 7. Club scholarships, in addition to the above, require a Club member sponsor.
- 8. The Club member sponsoring an applicant must be a member in good standing of the club for 36 months (3 years).
